Gloucestershire Grammar Schools

There are seven Grammar Schools in Gloucestershire, two of which are co-ed (Pates Grammar School and The Crypt School), two are boys only (Sir Thomas Rich's Grammar School and Marling School) and three are girls only (Denmark Road High School, Ribston Hall High School and Stroud High School). Each school has its own admissions criteria and we recommend visiting the school's website if you wish to check any information about a particular school.

What is the 11+ Test?

The Gloucestershire 11+ Test is currently based on GL Style Assessment.

The GL 11+ Test asks questions based on Verbal Reasoning (21 types), English, Maths and Non-Verbal Reasoning. There are two papers that last approximately 50 minutes in duration that are divided into timed sections.

Your child will take the test in the September they start Year 6. The test usually takes place at the grammar school listed first on your registration form and you will receive information from the school closer to the date.

Getting Started

Moving from primary to secondary school can be overwhelming at the best of times, particularly if this is the first time you have experienced this process!

At Cots Ed, we are with you for the whole of your Grammar School journey from finding out more about the Grammar School process up to taking the actual test and any subsequent appeals you may undertake. We run regular Parent/Carer Information evenings that are free to attend. You can also find more information on our website.

Do I need a tutor?

To pass the 11+ you definitely don't need a tutor, but it is very likely that without a tutor your child will need support from their parents or carers. As with any test that your child will take (from SATs through to GCSEs and beyond!), having an idea of what the test will look like and how to answer the questions is very helpful.

GL Assessment, which is the test provider for Gloucestershire, provides free materials to use for practice and there are other suitable materials on sale. The verbal reasoning and non-verbal reasoning sections take a bit of getting used to as the types of question are new to many, but certainly not so difficult that most adults couldn't help their child prepare. The English and Maths sections are related to the school curriculum.

It's said that you can get into grammar school without tutoring, and some people say that was the case with their child. However, the reality is that having some preparation is incredibly useful, even if formal tuition is not used. A tutor can be helpful, especially if they are experienced with GL tests and can provide guidance. If you don't want to or are unable to use a tutor, then keep an eye out for our free parent/carer information evenings. We will be talking about what the test involves, as well as tips and tricks for how you can help your child prepare. We also provide group tuition, courses and highly recommend our mocks, which give your child a genuine sense of what the exam conditions will be like.





If your child has SEND or medical needs, you might be wondering whether taking the 11+ exam is the right path, or if there are any access arrangements that may help them.

The schools will all adhere to the Equal Opportunities regulations. For example, the Pates Admissions Policy states 'The School acts at all times in accordance with the Equality Act 2010 and will therefore consider a request for reasonable adjustments from the parents of any disabled child who wishes to attend the school for the Test. Parents should notify the School when they register if their child will need additional support on Test day.'

In order to apply for reasonable adjustments, you will need to provide recent evidence of any diagnosis, or a recent My Plan/My Plan+ or EHCP. The grammar school may also contact your child's primary school to ask for further information.

Examples of types of reasonable adjustments may include: extra time, rest breaks, smaller group in the classroom, an individual room, a pre-test visit, an early entry time, a reader, a scribe or toilet breaks.

This is not a complete list, so please contact the school directly to ask for more information on what support your child may be eligible for.

What support do we offer?

At Cotswold Education we want to make every child's test preparation as comfortable as possible. We are a fully inclusive organisation and aim to make reasonable adjustments for any child who may need them in order to access our events.

All of our in-person events are in fully accessible spaces with an accessible toilet available. Our online events can have closed captions provided for any pupil or parents with a hearing impairment.

We provide a SEND room at selected Mock Tests for pupils with identified SEND needs. These may include adjustments for extra time and rest breaks as well as a quieter space in which to sit the test. We can also offer early entry to pupils who may need a quieter start to the test.

Children may use any equipment that they are authorised to use at school (e.g. overlays, ear defenders etc). We have staff at our events who have experience of supporting children with additional learning needs.

For all our in-person or online events, please get in touch with a member of our team if your child has any specific needs that we can help with.

Events & Bookings

We run both online and in-person events. Our online events usually take place on Zoom. You can find out more about the venue for our in person events on the individual event booking page.

All bookings are made through our secure booking site, which is linked to our website. If you have a child receiving free school meals, please contact us as we offer a number of discounted or free places at our events.

If you need to cancel a booking or if you or your child is ill on the actual day, please let us know as far in advance as possible so we can discuss this with you.

If you haven't already, it's worth signing up to our mailing list to receive regular updates about any changes to the 11+ test as well as information on upcoming events and discounts. We take safeguarding very seriously. All tutors hold an enhanced DBS certificate and we have a Qualified Paediatric First Aider at each event. Our safeguarding policy can be found on our website. We complete a thorough risk assessment for each of our events and access to events is restricted and monitored. When you sign up for an event, you will be asked information about your child including whether you are happy for us to take photos/videos, information on allergies and any other needs we need to be aware of. You are welcome to get in touch if you have any concerns or questions.

Personal Consultations

We're always happy to answer your questions about our events and to chat over a cup of coffee at our mock tests. We can also help by email or over the phone.

There are many things that you can do to help your Year 4 child prepare. Much of the 11 test is based on the school curriculum (particularly Maths and English) so supporting them with school work set by their teachers will also help them with the 11+. Part of handling the verbal reasoning questions is having a good vocabulary. You can help your child develop their vocabulary in a number of ways such as by encouraging them to read (or reading with them), playing vocabulary based games (e.g. scrabble, or online word games) or just by talking to them! This year we are introducing our first Online Group Tuition course for children in Year 4. This course introduces 11+ concepts, knowledge and question types in a relaxed and engaging way by using a variety of appropriate puzzles and games.

Online Parent/Carer Information Evenings

When your child reaches Year 4, it's natural to start thinking about what the next step in their school journey will be. If it is the first time you have gone through this process, it can feel overwhelming to know where to start, particularly regarding grammar schools!

Our Online Parent/Carer Information Evenings take place on Zoom and for Year 4 parents we focus on general ways you can support your child before they start more formal preparation for the 11+ test. We discuss fun and entertaining ways to help your child to improve a range of skills which are beneficial for the 11+ test and beyond!

We will also talk about games and activities that you can use to make learning fun, whether or not you end up applying for grammar school.

Year 4 Online Group Tuition Courses (Live)

In 2024/25 we will be running two 11+ courses for children in Year 4 that will last for 8 weeks. Each course can be taken individually or as part of a year long programme. The courses aim to help your child begin their 11+ journey in a fun and engaging way. We will use a variety of puzzles and games that have been created by CGP publishers as well as our own resources to encourage 11+ development. The courses will support the English and Maths components featured in the National Curriculum but we will also introduce the verbal and non-verbal question styles that will likely be new to your child.

The courses will run online, "live" on Zoom and the emphasis will be on developing the foundational skills and knowledge necessary to be ready for any more formal preparation that is done in Year 5. The courses are also ideal if you have children that are unsure about the 11+ test and would benefit from an informal yet structured approach that can prevent 11+ burnout.

Please note that these are two separate courses and if you would like to enrol your child on both, you will need to book a place on both courses. You will also need to purchase the CGP materials that go alongside the course (details for which are on our booking site).



11+ Activity Day

Learning to help develop skills and build confidence!

Our Activity Day takes place in the summer for children who have just completed Year 4. It is suitable for any child considering the 11+ or more generally honing academic skills for Year 5

The day is repeated in February for Year 5 children.

It is well documented that information and skills learnt in fresh settings (particularly those involving fun activities) enable easier retention. With this in mind, our activity days utilise the expertise of our experienced tutors to help children develop skills and knowledge through enjoyable games and tasks.

We will focus on developing a range of English, Maths and Non-Verbal skills that appear in the national curriculum and in the 11+ test. Your child will use and develop skills like logic and teamwork to solve teambased challenges.

An added bonus is that children often make new friends taking part in the fun activities.

11+ Book Club

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New for 2024/25, our free book club is intended to nurture a love of reading within the Cotswold Education community. All books are of suitable academic level for children in Year 4 who may wish to sit the 11+ exam.

This will be a monthly online book club where we will provide a selected list of books for each session, related to a particular genre. From here, the group will select the book for each month.

We will provide appropriate questions that can be used as a guide for discussion, matching the chosen book, and an activity relating to it for children to complete if they wish.

It is anticipated that the book club will become self-supporting with parents/carers (who will complete a DBS check as necessary) hosting future book club meetings.

Online Parent/Carer Information Evenings

At the start of Year 5 it's time to start thinking about your grammar school journey—if you haven't already! Knowing where to get high quality information and "what is right" when it comes to grammar school preparation can be difficult, particularly when there are often many views shared on forums and social media.

Our Online Parent/Carer Information Evenings take place on Zoom and aim to give all parents/carers the information you need to support your child. We believe that parents/carers should have access to reliable information to aid you in making informed decisions about what school is best for your child. These meetings are free to all and there is no expectation that you book onto one of our paid events.

During these sessions, we will discuss all aspects of the Grammar School process from learning about Gloucestershire Grammar Schools and the 11+ test, to how you can help your child prepare, with or without a tutor.

From time to time we run special sessions on particular aspects of the application process such as results day drop in sessions and a meeting on filling in the Common Application Form. Please keep in touch to get the latest information on our free sessions.

11+ Activity Day

Weekly Group Tuition

Our highly successful group tuition classes are returning for 2024/25.

We run two separate tuition courses, each running on one evening per week with the first lasting for 8 weeks and the second for 10 weeks. You can choose to enrol your child on one course or enrol them in both to support your child with progressing from being new to the 11+ right up to being ready to take the test. The first course is aimed at those new to the 11+ and covers each element of the 11+ test (English, Maths, VR and NVR). The second course builds on skills learned and children will progress to doing practice tests to start gaining confidence in "real" 11+ questions. Both courses use resources from CGP, which is a highly respected 11+ publisher.

The course is run by two of our staff who are highly qualified teachers with 11+ tutoring experience. We have low staff:student ratios for these sessions. Each session will be online and focus on the material for that week. There will then be "homework" set each week that we estimate should take your child no more than an hour to complete.

Short Courses

We run two short courses, the Spring Course and the Summer Grammar Crammer. Both courses run over 5 mornings in one week, lasting 2.5 hours with a 15 minute break. They are led by two highly experienced tutors and the courses do not duplicate one another.

The **Spring Course** is suitable for children who are new to the 11+ and also for those who have done some basic studying, but would like some more practice and skill development. Each session includes elements of English, Non-Verbal Reasoning, Verbal Reasoning and Numerical Skills. The sessions are interactive and we encourage students to engage in active learning. By the end of the course, your child will feel confident in tackling a range of GL style 11+ questions, but they will also have enhanced knowledge of the school curriculum to help them in their day-to-day lessons.

The **Summer Grammar Crammer** is a more intensive course that assumes your child is aware of the key question types. We will support students to increase their depth of knowledge whilst teaching a range of tips and techniques, that past students have found useful in helping them achieve high scores in the test.

Each course includes a booklet of optional extension activities for your child to carry out independently or with their family, helping them to further develop their understanding of the 11+ test topics. The courses run in the school holidays

16 Booster Classes NEW

Our Booster Classes aim to support your child with securing the basic skills and knowledge required in the given subject areas. They focus on a particular element of the 11+ test and are useful if your child is struggling with a particular question type or area of study. Each class will explain the key ideas and help your child to recognise how they can approach tricky questions and provide guidance when things get tough. Booster Classes aim to support your child with developing foundational skills in the area they are struggling with. The sessions will take place online and last for 1 hour. There is no limit to how many sessions your child can join and we will add more as the year progresses.

We run Booster Classes on:

- Alphabet codes.
- Comprehension.
- Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar (SPAG).
- Fractions.
- Shapes & Angles.





Masterclasses

Our Masterclasses run similarly to Booster Classes but are for children who are already performing reasonably well in that particular element and want to achieve higher scores in the test.

Each Masterclass is dedicated to one topic in the 11+ test. The sessions take place online and last for one hour. As with our other online events, we encourage your child to take part in the interactive elements, but they are welcome to just sit and listen if they would like. The masterclasses begin by focusing on understanding the topic we are discussing before moving onto tips, tricks and shortcuts to help your child answer these questions more quickly and accurately. There is no limit to how many sessions your child can join.

We run Masterclasses on:

- Verbal Reasoning (four different sessions).
- Maths (Arithmetic Tips, Fractions, Shapes & Angles).
- Non-Verbal Reasoning (two different sessions).
- Comprehension.
- Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar.
- Ready for Anything (extra potential topics).



11+ Mock Tests

Our GL Style 11+ Mock Tests give an authentic experience of what sitting the 2025 Grammar School Entrance Test will be like. The tests comprise of two full length papers taken under supervised exam conditions in a secondary school venue. The test is taken with other children to help build your child's confidence in this environment. The tests are designed to be relatively challenging, whilst enabling all students to gain experience of test conditions. There is a refreshment break between the papers.

Parents/Carers are welcome to stay and chat with our experienced staff over free refreshments. We'll also have a range of books and other resources for you to browse and buy. You don't have to bring anything with you other than a snack and drink for your child during the break between papers.

After your child sits the paper, you will receive an extensive, individually prepared report with raw marks, percentage marks and ranking position, which will be emailed to you within 7 days of the test. We also provide a summary of your child's performance and recommendations for how they can improve their scores. We will send you your child's marked answers sheets after the test with a link to a feedback video going through all of the questions and giving the correct answers. We even include some useful hints and tips in these videos, which will help with future tests.



Can my child sit more than one test?

We write all of our mock papers and no paper has ever been distributed. We can guarantee that your child won't have sat the paper before. Each date has a different paper, so your child can sit as many mock tests as they want. Please note that the papers on the morning and afternoon sessions are the same so please don't book two tests on the same day.

>>>> Why sit a Mock Test?

Practicing 11+ questions is really helpful but this on its own doesn't necessarily prepare your child for what it will be like to sit the actual test. This is where attending a mock test can be very beneficial. Sitting a mock test gives your child the chance to practice being in an environment with peers, under exam conditions. This can help them feel more comfortable with the environment and children often show a marked improvement over several mocks.

The actual pass mark for an 11+ exam changes yearly, so your child's ranking can tell you more about how likely they are to get into the school of their choice than the individual scores on the practice paper.

We have been running mock tests for over 12 years. The means we are able to provide you with a ranking that will give you a good idea of what school your child is likely to get into.

Our 11+ Summer Camp is dedicated to supporting your child with 11+ preparation whilst responding to the more relaxed summer dynamic. Teaching is delivered in small groups using a low staff:student ratio.

Sessions have been carefully planned to include all elements of the grammar school exam using a mixture of digital learning, workbook based activities and practical, kinetic, dynamic group work. The camp runs over two days and covers all four elements of the test.
